Le jury laissera le candidat poser plusieurs questions et se montrera hésitant pour inciter le candidat à poursuivre son questionnement.

QUESTIONS POSSIBLES:

- Would you like to stay in the town of Limoges or would you like to spend a few days in the countryside?
- Would you like to stay in a self-catering gîte or do you prefer a hotel and restaurant? (a gîte is a house in the countryside with common furnishings)
- Would you like to go sightseeing in Limoges or do you prefer to go fishing and hiking?
- Would you like to enjoy a gourmet dinner or do you prefer to cook your own meals?
- How much are you ready to spend?
- How would you like to celebrate your wedding anniversary?

LE CANDIDAT POURRA PRESENTER UN ETABLISSEMENT DE FACON PLUS APPROFONDIE

Par exemple :

Hotel Richelieu is a three -star hotel. They have an all-in price for 3 days and 2 nights which includes a double room, breakfast, a gourmet dinner with drinks, a bottle of champagne and a visit of a porcelain museum. It even includes 2 extra beds for your children if they are under 2. How old are they?

So it will amount to €229 per adult. That is to say €458 for the four of you. This is ideal! What do you think? Shall I make a reservation? (vérifier l'exactitude des informations notées sur la fiche de réservation)

II

Visits: the porcelain museum, the butchers' district, the town hall and its fountain, porcelain and enamel shops, the cathedral and the City's district around it with its old wooden-beamed houses, the Fine Art Museum with paintings by Renoir who was born here, Adrien Dubouché Museum, Casseaux porcelain oven/furnace museum and why not go to the Resistance Museum or to Aquapolis spa and watersport centre?

Souvenirs: porcelain, enamels, food

Food:

- "galetois" which are buckwheat pancakes filled with hot goat cheese and eggs
- Black pudding with chestnuts or apples
- Fish like perch or pike perch or trout
- Meat like our famous Limousin beef or veal from milk and grass fed calves or mutton or Baronet lamb
- Hazelnut cakes, Arena cakes (with almond paste), cherry pies, marzipan cakes from Saint-Léonard, madeleine cakes

Drinks: Branceilles wine, Kaolin (an aniseed-based aperitif), chestnut liqueur, red berry liqueur
