What we do

Oxfam is a global movement of millions of people who share the belief that, in a world rich in resources, poverty is not inevitable. In just 15 years, extreme poverty has been halved. 15 more years and we can end it for good.

We will always act, we will speak out, and we won't live with poverty.

What we achieved last year

3.9 million people reached by health promotion activities

400,000 people benefiting from support to improve their crops, goods or services

1.4 million people benefiting from improved sanitation facilities

For every £1 you give to Oxfam

84p goes directly to emergency, development and campaigning work

8p is spent on support costs

8p is invested to generate future revenue

Our methods, approaches and partnerships

We believe that all people are entitled to decent work and income security and to essential services such as health and education, and that everyone should have gender equality, security from conflict and disasters, and be able to participate in social and political life.

Poverty in the UK

The UK is the world's sixth largest economy, yet **20% of the UK population live below our official poverty line (66% are women)**, meaning that they experience life as a daily struggle.

Oxfam's vision is for everyone in the UK to have enough to live on, and for all men, women and children to be treated with respect and dignity no matter how much money they have. We believe it is unacceptable that over 13 million people in the UK do not have enough to live on, and most do not have the power to speak out about what this feels like and why it is wrong. We work with others to achieve a fairer and more equal country, in which everyone in the UK can live free from poverty and shame. We do this in three ways:

We develop projects to improve the lives of people living in poverty

We work with policy-makers to tackle the causes of poverty

We raise public awareness of poverty to create pressure for change

Discrimination and prejudice play a large role in the lives of people experiencing poverty. That is why challenging negative attitudes and addressing gender and race inequality are integral parts of our work.
