- Comptez les mots de l'ensemble. +/- 180 mots

Suggestions that will make starting a new job easier

- If you are not going into the same job field, consider what type of job would give you the most pleasure. Another thing you will need to consider is whether or not this new job is something that will last. Is this a short- term or a long-term proposition? Will the new job provide everything that you need? Medical insurance, benefits and retirement are all important things to consider.
- Will you need to have special skill training? Does your new job require you to have specific certifications? If so, you will need to think about what training providers you may want to enlist and how long the course will take.
 - If you have a Job Centre in your area, stop in and speak to them about the requirements for a new job. They can also advise you about what job opportunities you have in your area.
- Once you have a plan and get any certification you need, it is time to look for your new job.

 Create a good CV and keep it up to date. Choose the right clothes to wear for your interviews.

 A good outlook and a positive attitude can serve you well in getting a new job. Just remember the first impression can make all the difference in whether or not you get a second interview.
